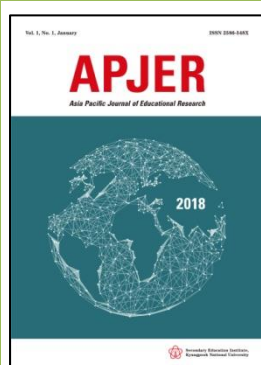

[Manuscript Guidelines]

Format

A manuscript should include title, affiliation including corresponding author's information, abstract of 200 to 250 words, keywords of 4 to 5, and references. Acknowledgement and notes can be included optionally. The manuscript should have a format given in the APA (American Psychological Association) 7th edition. The manuscript should be written in Microsoft Word file with a font of 12 point size. The length of the manuscript should be 6 to 20 pages, but it can be flexible.
