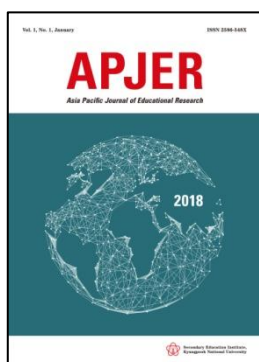


Asia Pacific Journal of Educational Research

[Manuscript Guidelines]

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Manuscripts should include title, affiliation including corresponding author's information, abstract of 200 to 250 words, keywords of 4 to 5, and references. Acknowledgement and notes can be included optionally. All manuscripts should have a format given in the APA (American Psychological Association) 7th edition. Manuscripts should be written in Microsoft Word file with a font of 12 point size. The length of manuscripts should be from 6 to 20 pages, but it is flexible.

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
